Features of EBSCO HOST.

- EBSCO HOST offers valuable tools for students conducting research:
- The ability for students to save articles directly into their Google Drive.
- Print, save, & email articles.
- Properly format and cite the article in various formats (MLA, APA,
 Chicago).
- Limit search results by years, format (newspaper, magazines, scholarly articles).
- Many articles have the option to be read to the viewer, similar to an audio book.
- The ability to search for photographs, maps, and other primary sources.


Databases

Databases are a great tool for doing research. To access the databases from home you will need the access codes posted below. Google Scholar & WolframAlpha do not require an access code.










EBSCOHOST ADVANCED SEARCH OPTIONS: Boolean Search


Boolean search is a type of search allowing users to combine keywords with operators (or modifiers) such as **AND**, **NOT** and **OR** to further produce more relevant results. For example, a Boolean search could be "hotel" AND "New York". This would limit the search results to only those documents containing the two keywords.






EBSCOHOST SEARCH RESULTS




By clicking on "**All Filters**", users have the options to limit their results to: publication years, scholarly journals (peer reviewed), magazine articles, news articles, pictures...etc.
