


Databases are a great tool for doing research. To access the databases from home you will need the access codes posted below. Google Scholar & WolframAlpha do not require an access code.


### Accessing CultureGrams

For off campus access the Username is: Nevada & the Password is: silver1!


No password is needed if accessing from a computer connected to the school's computer network (on campus).

#### Using CultureGrams




Students have a choice of accessing different databases within CultureGrams depending on their research topic. If researching a state, use the States Edition. If researching a Canadian province use the Provinces Edition. Researching a country students will use the World Edition.

Example: States Edition - Nevada




When researching a state, province, or country students have access to a wide variety of information. Students have the options to translate the article, listen to the article and to link their Google Account to easily save the information to their Google Drive.

## Example: World Edition




When researching a country, pick the continent than the country. Researching a country will give students the same research functions & options as the states database (translate, save to Google Drive, audio...etc).

### Citing Sources in CultureGrams



Each article within CultureGrams allows students to easily cite their sources in either APA 7 or MLA 8 by clicking on the "Generate Citation" option.

## Using the Graphs & Tables Option



The Graphs & Table features allows students to easily create custom graphs & tables to compare & contrast up to 10 different countries, states, and provinces on 4 different categories of their choosing.
